

Well Visits and Immunization Schedule

- Birth : Hep B #1 , Newborn Screen while in hospital.
- Newborns: Seen in office within 1week if breastfeed.
2 weeks if bottle fed unless parents have concerns.
- 2 Weeks : Physical Exam and Newborn Screen #2
- 1 Month : Physical Exam & Hep. B #2 Vaccine
- 2 Months : Physical Exam , Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar 13 & Rotateq
- 4 Months : Physical Exam , Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar 13 & Rotateq
- 6 Months : Physical Exam , Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar 13 & Rotateq
- 9 Months : Physical Exam , Hep B # 3 Vaccine
- 12 Months: Physical Exam , MMR, Varicella , Prevnar 13 & Hep. A Vaccine
- 15 Months: Physical Exam & Pentacel #4
- 18 Months : Physical Exam & Hep A #2
- 24 Months: Physical Exam and Blood Work Order for Lead testing and Hemoglobin.
- 30 Months: Physical Exam
- 3 Years: Physical Exam
- 4-5 Years: Physical Exam, Dtap and IPV , MMR, Varicella, Hearing and Vision Screen
- 6-10 Years: Annual Physical Exam , Vision Screen
- 11 Years: Physical Exam , Vision Screen, Tdap, Menveo , HPV (2 doses before the age of 15) Blood Work
- 12-13 Years: Annual Physical Exam , Vision and Hearing Screen
- 14-15 Years: Annual Physical Exam , Vision Screen
- 16 Years: Physical Exam , Menveo, Vision Screen , Meningitis B Vaccine (2 Doses 4 weeks apart)
- 17-18 Years : Annual Physical Exam And Vision Screen

- All Physical exam visits include Developmental Screen .
- Flu Vaccines are recommended annually for patients 6 months of age and older.
